This is Kichao village, Mweka, where EA has now funded a project to pipe fresh water right into the village and provide a safe sustainable source for over 50 households.



Some of the villagers are walking a 2km round-trip more than 8 times a day for water! I was overwhelmed by the opportunity to make this life-changing project happen.
